Babo has been home for a couple of weeks and left Tues. for Baton Rouge to find out about school. I think he wants to start in right away.

All the kids, namely: Linda Ann & Frank Edward, arrived Thursday with Adrain & Corinne & stayed until Friday afternoon. As yet, they have not found a house in N.P. & so are staying in Opelousas for the time being. Adrain goes to work on the

1st of December.

I want to call my (own) Godchild Eddie. The Foxes want to call him "Frank & Mama & Steve & Daddy don't call him. In the meantime Corinne & etc. are calling him "Poppy" I don't think that a shame, I think it's terrible. And it's likely to stick. Look at "Babs".

We haven't heard from George in a good while & hope he is on the way. It was the same about you. We hadn't heard & so when we got your letter we were glad, of course, to hear from you but in a way a little disappointed because we were a little too optimistic in thinking that you were on the way.

Went to a ball game last night. The Coarvent was playing Cathedral High, Lybyette. We lost. The score was 27-12. Not so good. It was freezing & perfect for a game. The wind started changing around 3 P.M.

Received a letter from Vi. She is in Georgia with "Pop" her husband. He is stationed there. I think he intends to stay in the Army.
