Dear All:

I have received letters from M. Desire Almy of 19 Sept. 1983, 16 Nov. 1983, and 30 May 1984, which help flesh out the story and family tree of the Jamards of Normandy. The grandfather of Francois Jamard (II) (who married Eulalie Artache in 1831 in Lafayette and who is the ancestor of the Jeanmards of Louisiana), as you know from previous correspondence, was Jean Jamard, Sieur Du Pont, who owned land at Torigni and was a king's lawyer before the Revolution and who was still living at Torigni in 1800. His father was also a Jean Jamard, Sieur DuPont, who died at 1743 in Torigni; he was born at Figterolles in Normand (now in the Department of Calvados), the son of Louis Jamard and grandson of Pierre Jamard at Figuerolles. Louis married Anne Leliefre 20 Feburary ~~1791~~ 1691 at Figuerolles, and they had 5 other children besides the first Jean.

Enclosed is a family tree prepared by M. Almy. The other documents are too bulky or faded to reproduce, but I sent some of them to Edwin (Brother) Jeanmard to hold for me until I had a chance to try to translate them.

I hope this information is of interest to you.
